

UK North Sea well P&A Campaign

Working closely with our client and vendors and with minimal wellbore conditions known prior to well entry of the ageing high risk well, the EXCEED planning and execution team adjusted to the poor wellbore conditions, and commenced complex fishing operations over several runs.

A total of 135 well bore runs, including 87 successful fishing runs were performed within the wellbore, to attain successful access for barrier placement.

World First Section Milling

200ft of 13-3/8" casing was successfully milled in one single run at average 4ft/hour, and underreamed open hole to 20", a world first for the incumbent third-party vendor on a MODU semi-submersible.

AB1 barrier placed within the wellbore following collaboration with client's subsurface and reservoir departments for the successful movement of the AB1 barrier due to wellbore conditions.

Well completed to AB3 status successfully and safely.
